

sample of 20 offspring, you might get 15:5 or 13:7. The **Virtual Lab Breeding Mutation Fruit Flies Answers** are not a single number but a pattern. The larger your sample size, the closer you get to the expected ratio.

Q: How do I know if a mutation is on an autosome or a sex chromosome?

A: Look at the distribution of the trait between males and females. If a trait appears equally in both

sexes, it is likely autosomal. If it is more common in one sex (usually males for recessives), it is likely sex-linked. For example, white eyes appear almost exclusively in males when crossed properly.
